DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From the South and West

US 131 North to exit 142 (19 Mile Road). Turn east or right. Travel 1.5 miles to STOP sign. Turn left onto Northland Drive. Travel north for 2.5 miles through the small town of Paris. On the north end of Paris turn right onto Hoover Road. Follow Hoover Road east for 3.0 miles to 180th Avenue. Stay on paved road by turning right onto 180th Avenue. Go south 0.6 miles to 21 Mile Road and turn left. Travel 3.0 miles east on 21 Mile Road to 150th Avenue. The Grant Township Hall will be on the northeast corner of the road. Turn left onto 150th Avenue and travel north for 2.3 miles until road “T’s “ at the **STOP** sign at Stones Corners Road. Turn right and travel for approximately 1.0 miles until the road “T’s” at 140th Avenue. Turn right. The paved road will quickly turn to the left onto 23 Mile Road. Ignore the paved road and continue on 140th Avenue to the first drive on the right. You have reached Shooting the Breeze Hunt Club at Rolling Rock Ranch. The farm gates are green metal. A cream and green pole barn with a pheasant weathervane on the cupola set back from the road a short distance is the clubhouse and your preferred destination for quality pheasant hunting “As It Should Be”.

From the South and East

Reach the corner of M-66 and M-20 at Remus via your preferred route. Go north on M-66 through the small town of Barryton. 0.5 miles north of Barryton, turn left onto 20 Mile Road. Travel west for approximately 5 miles to 80th Avenue and turn right or north. Travel approximately 3.0 miles to 23 Mile Road and turn left onto 23 Mile Road. Travel west for approximately 5 miles to 140th Avenue. Turn left on to the unpaved portion of 140th Avenue and travel to the first drive on the right. You have reached Shooting the Breeze Hunt Club at Rolling Rock Ranch. The farm gates are green metal. A cream and green pole barn with a pheasant weathervane on the cupola set back from the road a short distance is the clubhouse and your preferred destination for quality pheasant hunting “As It Should Be”.
